HOUSE COMMITTEE HAPPENINGS for March 2023

Members All:

I am pleased to announce the House Committee members that will be serving with me this Lodge year: PER B. J. Black, Heidi Vargas, Gail Miller, Rose Ann Atanasio will help administer the Club business of Viera Lodge #2817. We are in the process of filling the two remaining spots.

We begin the year with a few housekeeping items: Our first order of business is to address G/L/S 17.052 which deals with service of alcohol. Specifically, we are prevented by conscience and by Grand Lodge from over-serving our Members or guests. The House Committee has instructed all bartenders to stop service to a particular member if there is any question. Let's all do our part, and make sure everyone gets home safely if there is ever any doubt. We will be posting notices concerning Section 17.052 G/L/S regarding prohibition against over-service.

We are also endeavoring to standardize the delivery method by which we offer bar service to Members and their guests. The correct "pour" for a highball is ONE jigger, plus an additional pass. All bartenders have been instructed to pour in this manner. IT IS NOT UP FOR DEBATE. If a particular member desires a stronger drink, they may purchase an additional shot. Bottled and draft beer, as well as single service wine carafes manage their own quantities.

As we enter the new Lodge year, we again remind all to PLEASE use YOUR membership and key card for entry to the Lodge. ANYONE ringing the buzzer for admittance will be asked to produce a current dues card by the bartender on duty. If you cannot produce your card, service will be denied. BE PROUD to show your card. This is for the protection of our Members as well as the Lodge. Please USE YOUR CARD to enter the Lodge facility. If we all march to the same tune, the Club management side of things will become much easier for all. THANK YOU for your support.

In April, we continue our usual pub style food menus. Crispy chicken wraps, Pot roast sammies and tots, or sliders on their typical Monday evenings. Hot dogs as noted on Tuesdays or Wednesdays. Dinners as announced on Fridays or Saturdays. Breakfast on the first and third Sundays of the month. We have something for every palate!!




