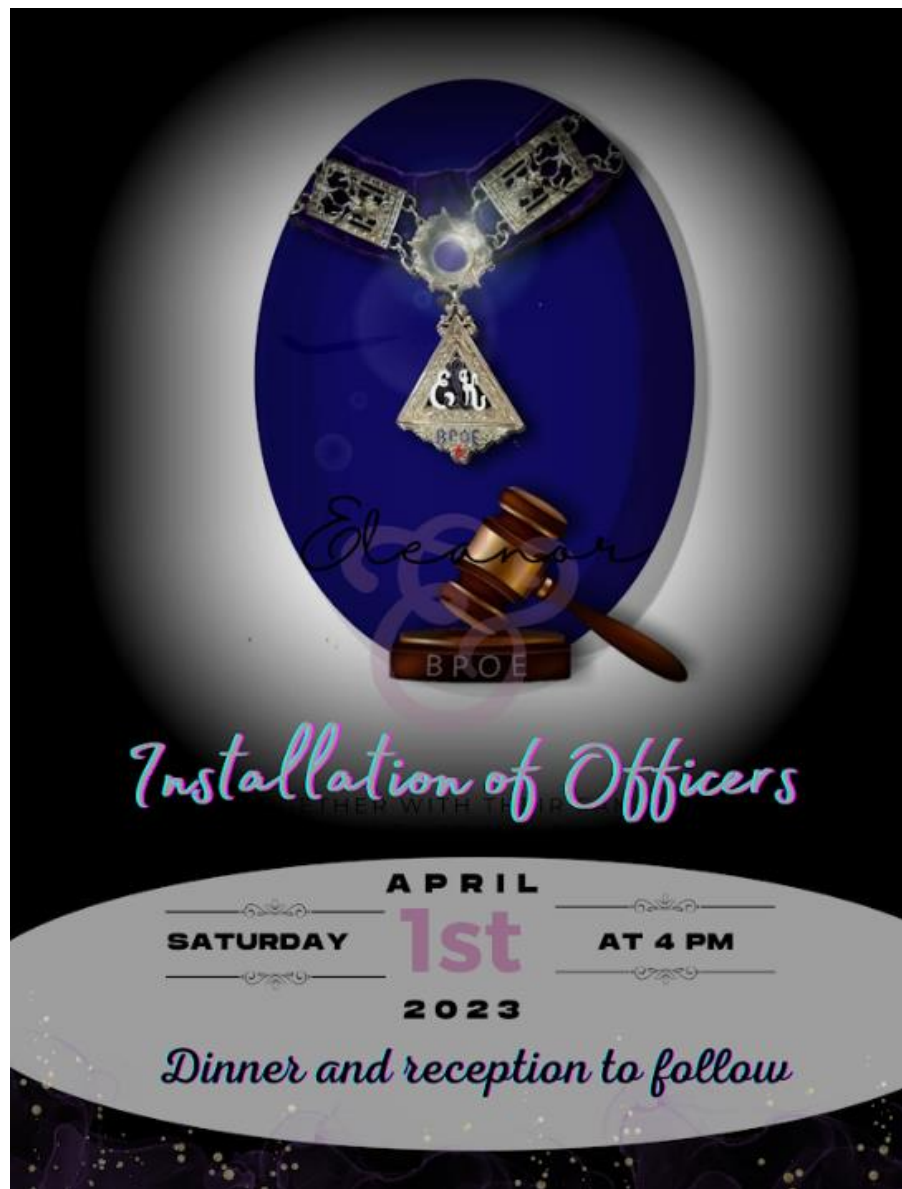

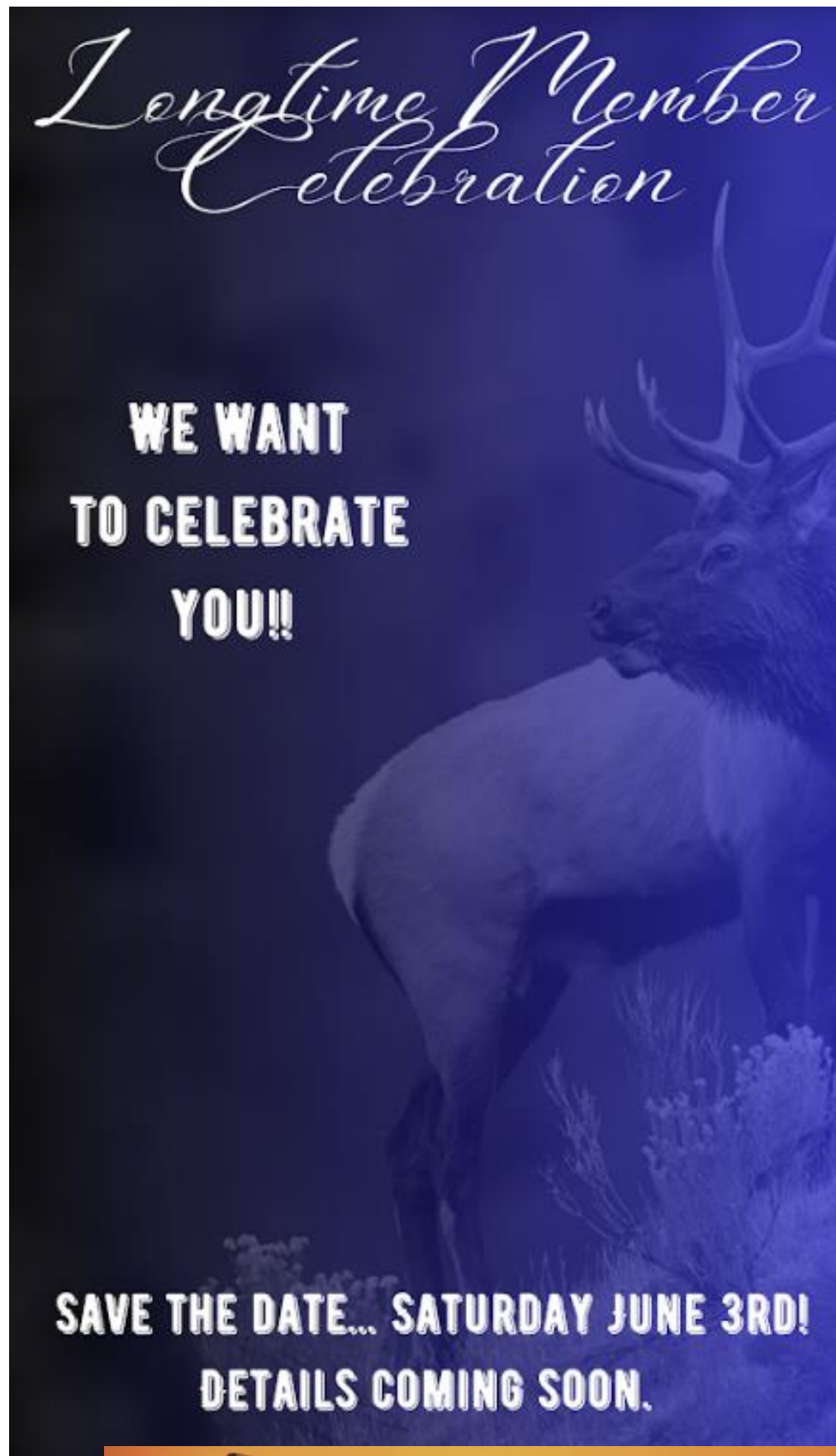

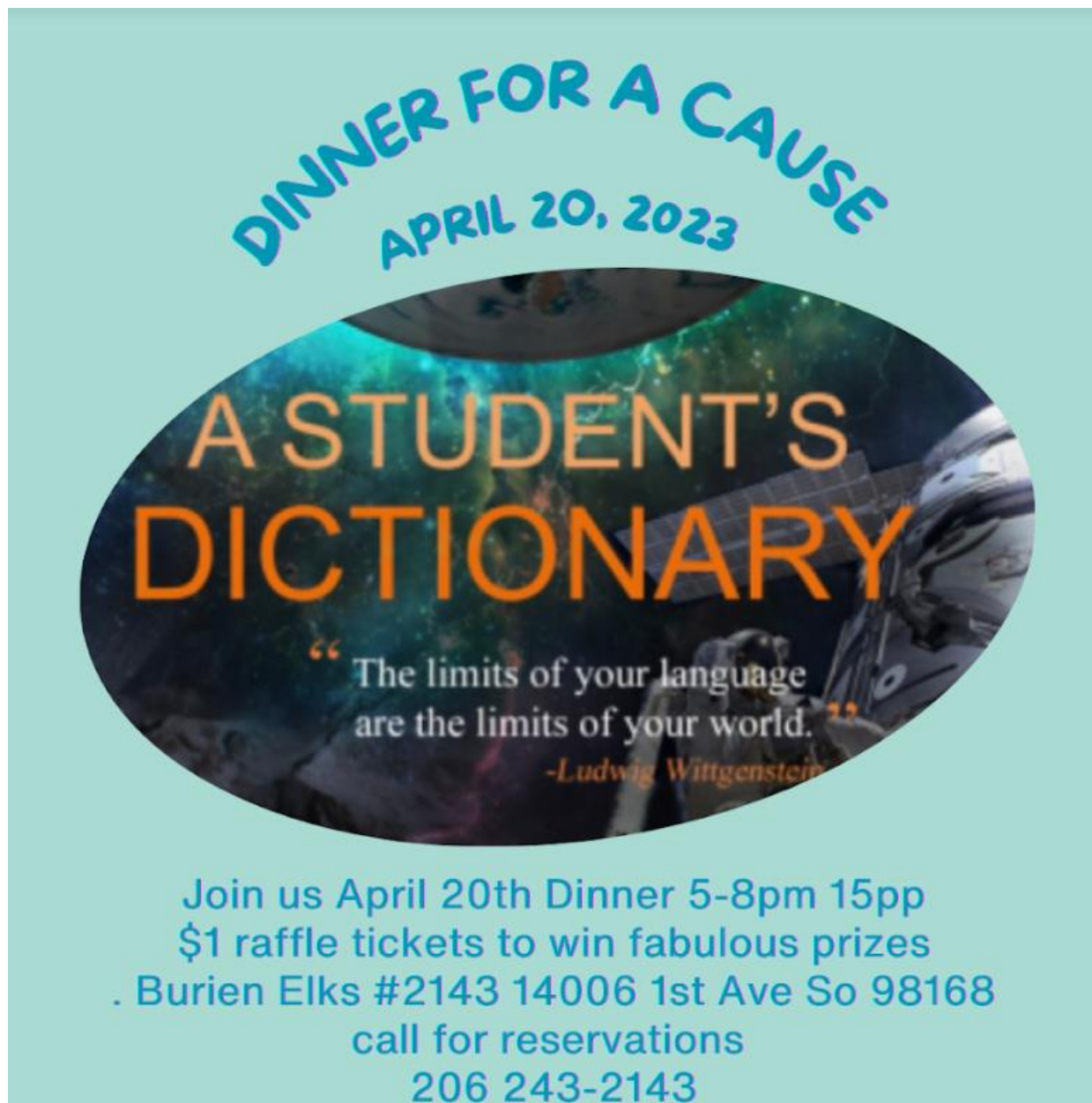
As your outgoing House Committee Chair....

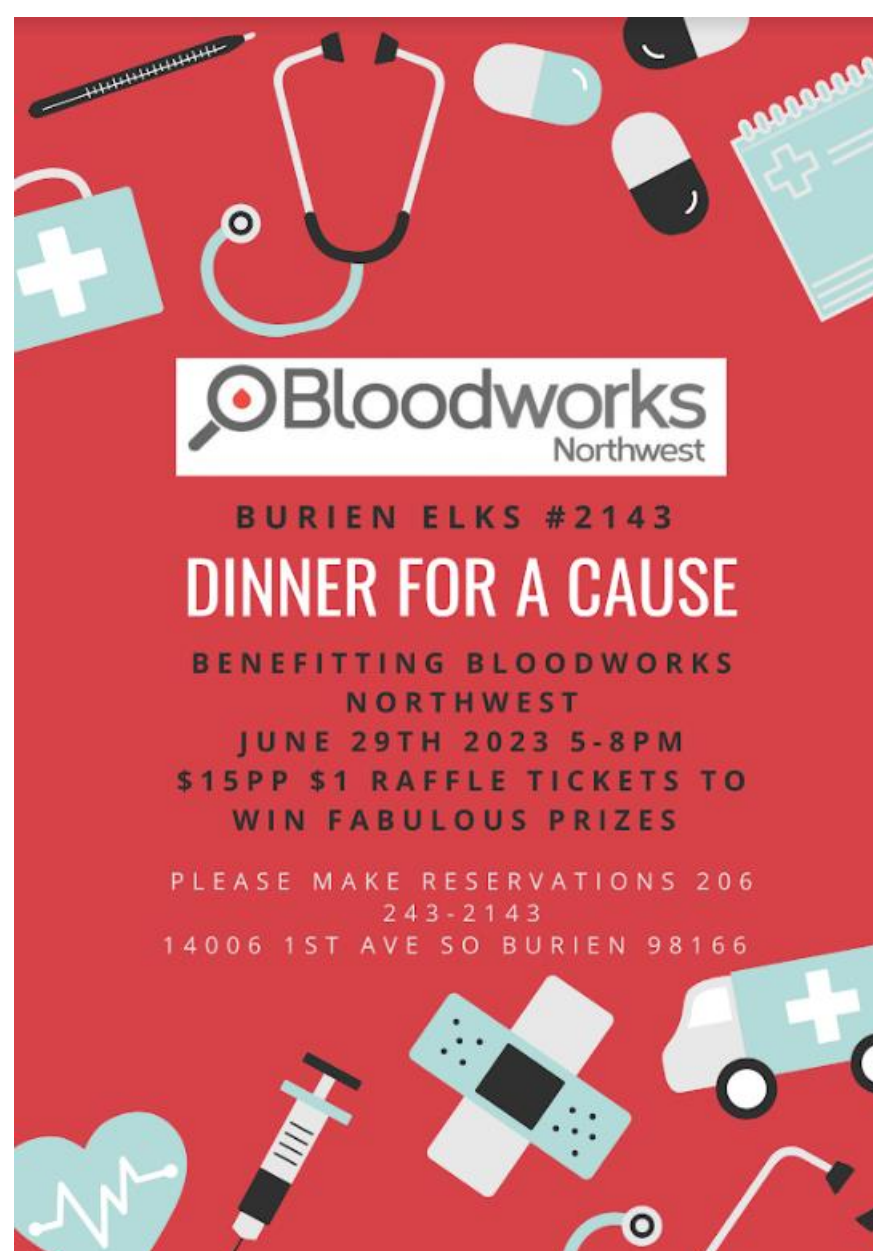
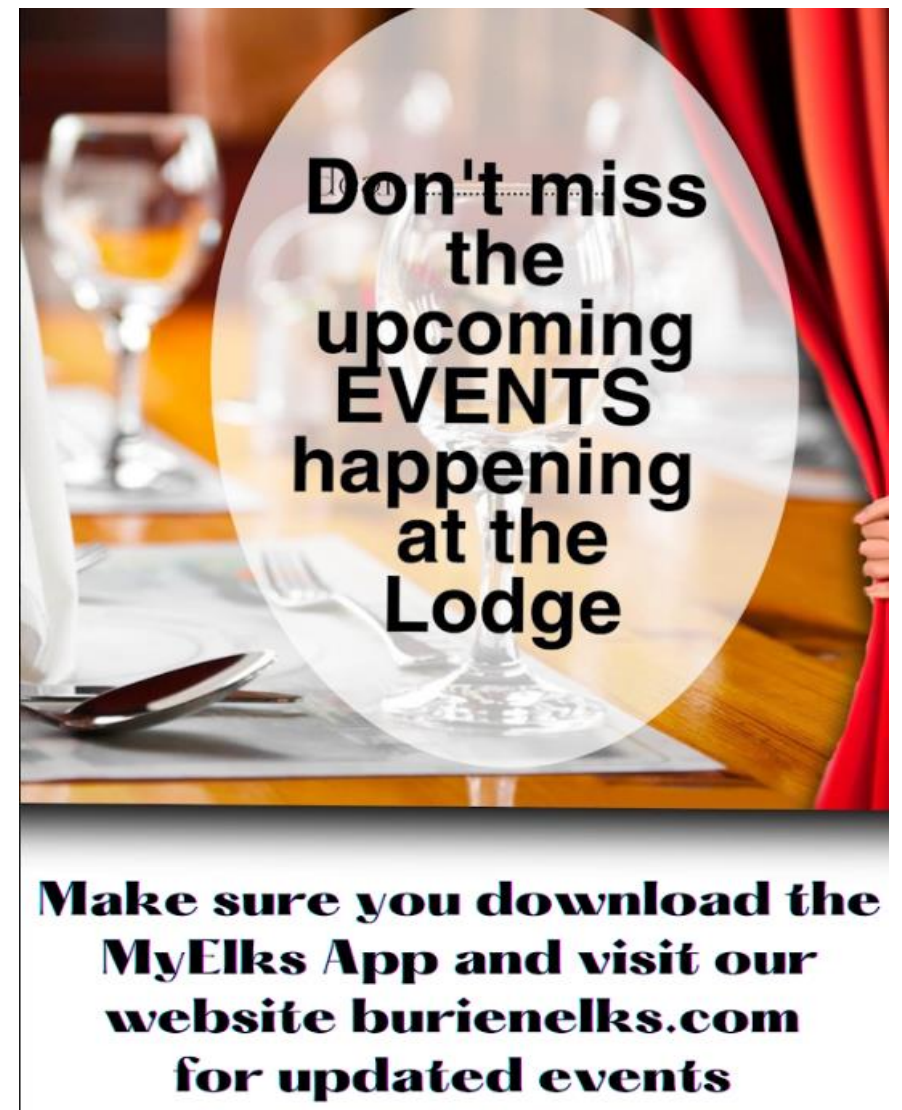
