Flag Day Ceremony on June 14th was a big success!

Local Elks Lodges throughout the United States, Guam, Puerto Rico, and the Panama Canal celebrated Flag Day on June 14, 2023. The Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks is the only fraternal organization to require a formal observance of Flag Day.

In July of 1908, the Elks' Grand Lodge provided for the annual nationwide observance of Flag Day on the 14th of June each year, making it mandatory for each subordinate Lodge in the Order. June 14 was officially established as Flag Day by a proclamation by President Woodrow Wilson in 1916. Flag Day was not a national observance until 1949—President Harry Truman, himself an Elks member, was inspired through his Lodge in Independence Missouri, to sign an act of Congress that dedicated June 14 to the symbol of our country.

On June 14, 2023, The West Des Moines Elks had their Flag Day Ceremony. It was well attended by our

members and their guest. Thank You, to Larry Cramer for bringing along his bugle to play Taps at the end of the service.

Letter from our State President: State Major Project Research Team

Dear Exalted Ruler, Lodge Officers & Members,

As many of you know or don't know, The Iowa Elks Association's Major Project is the Fire Safety Initiative. The Elks Fire Safety initiative promotes fire safety across the State of Iowa. Many people know that the Fire Safety Trailers help children learn how to get out of a burning building and/or the ongoing partnership with the State Firefighters Association, but how many of us knew that the Fire Safety Initiative included teaching both children and adults how to recognize fire hazards in their homes, dial 9-1-1, install and check smoke detectors, and severe weather awareness? The Fire Safety house has two programs: One is how to call 911 during an emergency and the second one is what you should do during a tornado or severe weather.

The Elks' Mission through fire safety instruction is to prevent death, personal injury or harm, and any personal property damage caused by fires. The main goal for the State Major Project is to teach today's youth about the importance of knowing fire safety and being safe in severe weather.

While we are very proud of the many lives saved & the work that has been done to promote this program, there has been much discussion about supporting a new major project as the current project is not getting much enthusiasm from the local lodges. This project has two more years left with us financially supporting the Blank Hospital's Fire Trailer. This does not mean we would abandon the Fire Safety Initiative completely, but transition it to making it more of a State Committee instead of the State Major Project.

At this time, we are currently seeking a Research Committee to look into possible State Major Project ideas. We would like to put a team together to research what the other States are doing for their projects and see what we could do that would get more excitement and support from all of the members in lowa statewide.

So, if researching Elks.org and the internet for the different State associations websites to see what their Major Projects are sounds like something you may be interested in doing, or if you have an idea of something the Iowa Elks could get behind for a State Major Project, please contact me, Chris Elsberry at hwksw1n@gmail.com We would love to hear your ideas & would appreciate your support if you volunteer to be on this Research Committee!

Once the research is complete, all of the projects will be reviewed and will then be narrowed down to see what ones may work for Iowa. We want to make the biggest impact in giving back to communities all across the state as well as get the momentum going with excitement and more membership involvement.

The State Association would like to have each lodge read this letter at your Lodge meeting. In addition, please put this request out in your newsletters. We want ALL of your membership involved in this input! We want to know what you and your membership care about and what we, as lowa Elks can do to make the biggest difference in your communities.




