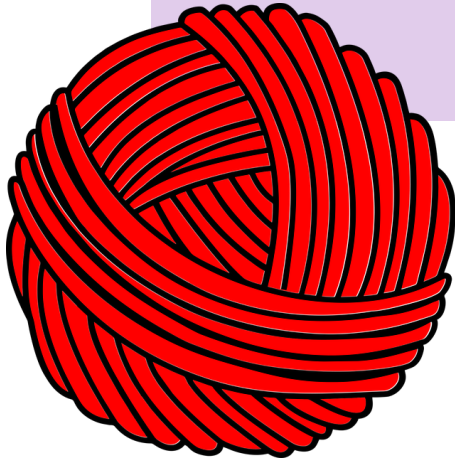


# CROCHETERS
