Beacon Grant

Tulsa Elks Lodge #946 Beacon Grant application was approved for The Tulsa Day Center for \$6000.00. The check was presented to Mack Haltom, Executive Director, and Holly Ehmen, Case Manager, on June 21, 2023. The Tulsa Day Center has served the homeless population in Tulsa County since 1986. They serve between 200-250 clients daily at the Center, including basic needs- clothing, hygiene products, shower, and food/snacks as needed. Also, the Tulsa Day Center provides Case Management services linking clients to community resources and housing. They also have a clinic that provides free medical services provided by retired doctors and the Tulsa Day Center nursing staff. The generous donation from Lodge Members for clothes and summer needs two deliveries were made to the Day Center. Very Proud of our team that served dinner Monday, August 7, 2023, for the residents who also receive night shelter services. Our team prepared the Mexican meal at the Lodge and served 83 meals.
