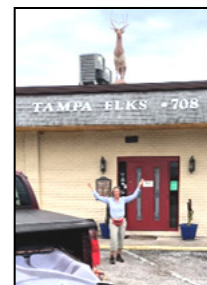



AED Donation
