



# Lounge Price Adjustments Effective Monday, December 4th

Inflation is hitting the fraternal and social clubs just as hard as other service industries. We are all grappling with increased costs for resale products, gas/delivery charges, utilities and employee payroll.

Amid the nation's soaring inflation, just this year - beer prices have risen about 5-6%. Distilled liquor and wine are not doing much better and have seen an increase of 2-3%. Additionally, employee wages continue to increase due to new regulations on wages.

In reviewing our pricing we have found it necessary to raise prices on 10-20% of our products. We are working hard to keep the increases in the 25-50 cent range (1-2%) per/serving.

We are making every effort to keep our pricing low and competitive while still covering our costs and ensuring some profitability for unexpected expenses. Thank you for understanding. The Elks are still significantly cheaper, by at least 25, than most outside bat businesses!






