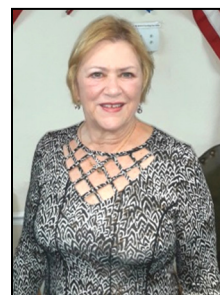

Camp sessions last from Sunday afternoon to Saturday morning and include housing, food, and of course, tons of fun! 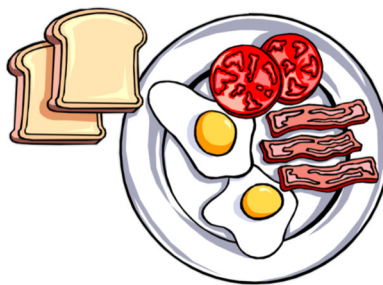

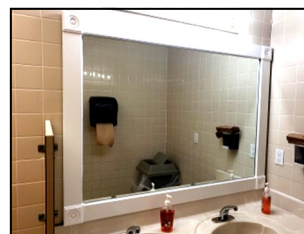
