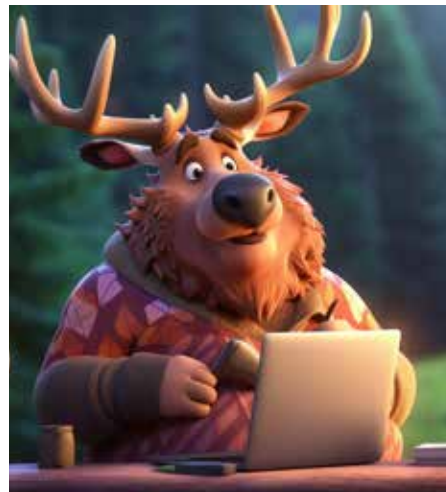

Happy New Year! 2024 is here already – and we have no snow, crazy, isn't it? I remember once in my life maybe that we didn't have snow on Christmas and now this year. I looked in my perennial garden today and I have phlox coming up already – I'd definitely be ok if we skipped winter and I could already start my garden planning.

2023 was a GREAT year regarding charitable gambling. Even with the new changes and all of that hullabaloo we still stayed strong. We added Mike's Pub in Hibbing and The Alibi Bar in Gilbert this year. So that means we get to give away so much more in those areas.

In December, we were able to give away over \$10,000 again to folks in our surrounding communities – I know you know it, but that is honestly the best part of this job! It's such a great feeling knowing we're helping our own students, Veterans, community members, etc.

In December we had a BLAST helping with the Stuff the Ambulance for the Salvation Army. We donated \$1,000 to that event (it was their best ever!) We also were able to purchase the cocoa and marshmallows for the stuff the ambulance event, the candy and hot dog meals for the Santa Visit event and the trophies for the Hoop Shoot! We take great pride in all of our donations!

Simply put, electronic pull-tabs (also referred to as E-Tabs) are digital, graphically enhanced versions of the traditional paper pull-tabs, and are played on an electronic device like a tablet or cabinet.

Like paper pull-tabs, electronic pull tabs are games of chance that reveal a set of symbols, characters and numbers with each play. E-Tabs have a finite number of tickets and a predetermined number of winners, payouts, and profits to the hosting organization. Electronic pull-tabs are typically used by licensed charitable and membership-based organizations, to enhance their membership experience by providing entertaining games while providing a way to increase revenue for their organization.
