FROM THE DESK OF THE SECRETARY

Most of our members should have received their dues renewal notices for 2024-2025. You may have noticed some differences. Our lodge participated for the first time in a program for the Grand Lodge to send the notices out rather than the lodge secretary. This will prove to be very helpful, however this year the line items for the Elk-O-Gram booster and the "In Memory" of tributes were missing. Anyone interested in continuing with or becoming a new booster or submitting an "In Memory" tribute please submit your information and \$10.00 payment either through the mail or to the secretary's inbox at the Lodge.

Thank-you all for your patience and understanding as we utilize this new process. A gentle reminder that your dues payments are due before April 1, 2024. Thank-you to all the early birds who have paid so far. An update will be given when the new cards are ready to be sent out.

Our February fundraising will once again focus on ENF (Elks National Foundation). Purchase a heart to decorate our lounge for Valentines Day but this time around we also have a clipboard to write down your name and donation amount so you can be recognized for your donation. It will begin at a \$5 donation, but any amount is welcome and appreciated. Donors of \$10 or more will receive a letter of recognition from the Grand Lodge. We have done fundraisers before but lodges all over the state will be doing their own ENF hearts so it is a great opportunity to show the rest of the state how generous Lodge #25 members are. When we meet our lodge goal of just under \$5 per member we qualify for an additional grant and after that we can qualify for bonuses. This is important because our grant projects will be a big part of the Lodge's charitable events in the upcoming Elk year. If we have participation of 15% of membership or more, increase our donations 10% over last year and add Fidelity Club (recurring monthly payment) members, we will qualify for bonuses. I already know New Haven Lodge #25 has the most heart, let's prove it!

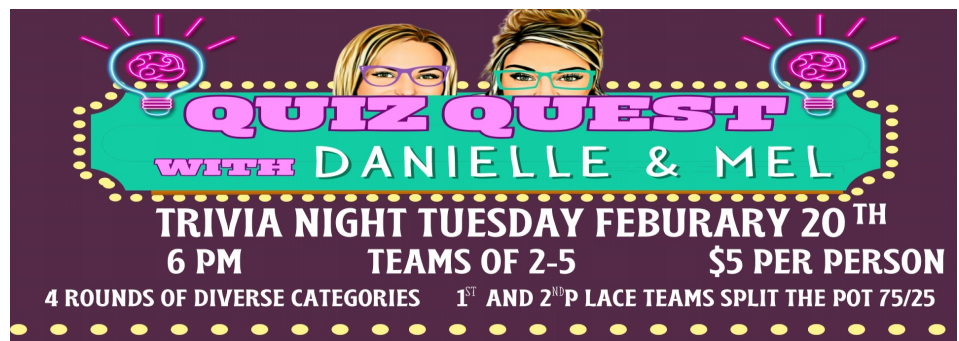

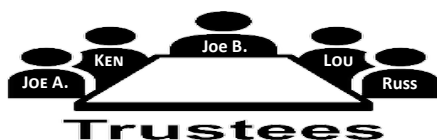
