Hello All,

March is the final month of the Elk Year. Dues need to be paid before April 1 to gain access to the lodge and to the Range. Please allow two weeks when mailing in your dues for new membership cards to be returned. Mail has been slow and there is a large number of dues still being processed. Unfortunately, we may lose over 50 member who remain delinquent on 2023-2024 dues.

March is also a Month to reflect on what the lodge has accomplished in the last year. It was a great year and I will cover a couple of the highlights. First, Dinners and Breakfast are back! These have been well received and supported by both volunteers and participants. Secondly, Membership growth continues at unprecedented levels, well over a 10% gain this year alone. In the few years as secretary, we have seen almost a 40% growth. Trustees have made major improvements to facilities with a new

Patio and upgrades to the heating and ventilation systems. Lastly our Range committee has been very active with their programs, training and even a new Beauties and Bullets program. Their sponsorship of dinners and raffles have made big contributions and support to lodge charitable activities.

The Lodge also has received \$6000 ir grants from ENF and \$1000 from the state to support local programs. This is in addition to the support of Camp Sunrise, Glastonbury Food Banks, Veteran's Dinner and several Youth/scouting Programs.

Personally, I want to thank all of the support I have received from the many volunteers for help with the secretary's office.

Major improvements have been made in the Upstart and social Media platforms, Membership committee has intervened and processed more than 200 new applicants! And finally to those volunteers who help with processing renewals and mailing out notices or dues to over 1300 members.

Spouse cards are issued to Spouses of Members in good standing. All cards must be requested by the member every year. Please note your request for spouse cards at time of renewal. There is no fee for Glastonbury Elks Spouse cards. The identification card is a privilege for Glastonbury Lodge 2202 and may not be recognized by other Elk Lodges. Spouse cards are for identification only and come with an access card to the lodge.

Spouse cards are not membership cards, therefore not eligible for Member rights. Identification cards holders cannot attend regular meetings, or be entitled to voting privileges.

Spouse/ Identification card Holders are:

- 2) cannot sign in guest to the lodge register.


