A word from the Exalted Ruler

WOW! What an amazing experience this past year has been. I am proud to have had the opportunity to serve as your Exalted Ruler for 2023-24. Together we have accomplished great things for our lodge, and we should all be proud of the fruits of our efforts.

When we started this adventure together our lodge was facing some serious challenges to keep the doors open and operating. First and utmost was the financial shortfall we were left with. I am happy to report that the Galveston Lodge #126 is in a solid financial state. The continuous support of members attending dinners, events and showing outstanding generosity has assisted in reaching this goal. Thank you to everyone who volunteered, and gave, to make this happen.

One of my goals this year was to get our message out to the public, the following shows we

did it. Our Memorial Day Service was performed at three Veterans Monuments. The Mayor of Galveston attended and read a proclamation declaring it Elks Memorial Day. We also made the front page of the newspaper. Our Veteran's Committee arranged for us to combine our Veteran's Day activities with the VFW, the American Legion and Marine Corp League into one event, when we were able to donate a car to a deserving Vet. Two of our newer members revived our DAP Program and it is going strong. Elks lodge had a booth at Dickens on the Strand and sold Mistletoe. The Veterans' Committee initiated a monthly Veterans Breakfast and acquired a grant allowing over 50 Veterans the opportunity to take a fishing trip, all free to Vets. A group of us went Christmas caroling to three different assisted living facilities and a special appearance at Eddie Janek's home.

In-house accomplishments include the acquisition of the loan from FTET, allowing for the new floor in the Main Hall and Pit Room renovations. We added 30-plus members to our membership and had a very successful Stampede celebration with all 300 tickets being sold. The Grand Prize winner, Kansas State President, Roger Slief, generously donated half of his prize back to our lodge. We also established a Members of the Month award to recognize volunteers going above

Teams are limited to 4 people per area. Booth size will be 10'x10'.

All cooking must be done on site; however, food prep can be performed beforehand. Items that may be done offsite include vegetable prep and rice preparation. Everything else must be prepared onsite.

All cook team members must be 21 and older, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian

Judging Criteria

Enter your gumbo in one of 3 categories for judging:

- Seafood
- Chicken and Sausage (no seafood in this one)
- Chiefs Choice (or kitchen sink Gumbo)

Appearance-looks like a good gumbo-roux color, etc.

Consistency-stirs like a good gumbo-thickness of base etc.

Texture-Balanced quantity of ingredients. Need to have some meat in every bite!

Flavor- tastes like a good gumbo, pleasing to the palate

Teams must have a great attitude, HAVE FUN.
Cooking conditions are subject to inspection, and Elks Officers in attendance will be judges (or their delegate).

of our ENF and to work with our committees in utilizing our grants for the people in our community.



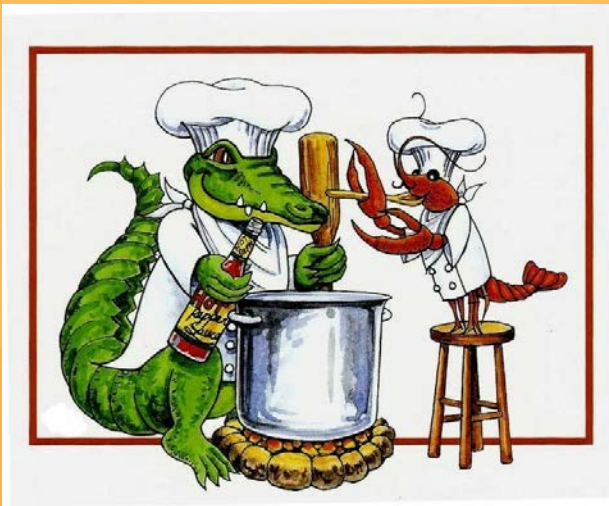

My name is Eric Ayles and I'm thrilled to be the new DAP Chair for the Elks 126. The Elks National Drug Awareness Program strives to teach all children and parents about the dangers of illegal drug use and prevent the abuse of legalized and prescription drugs. <https://www.elks.org/dap/aboutDAP.cfm>

This program started in 1982 but we need it now more than ever in our community. I work at a treatment center in Angleton called Serenity Light and my job is to help people find treatment options but sometimes it's too late. There is an epidemic of overdoses in our Galveston community due to fake drugs containing fentanyl. We must educate teens and young adults that fake pills are on the streets that look like other drugs and one pill can kill. Know that if you volunteer on this committee you can actually play a part in saving lives!

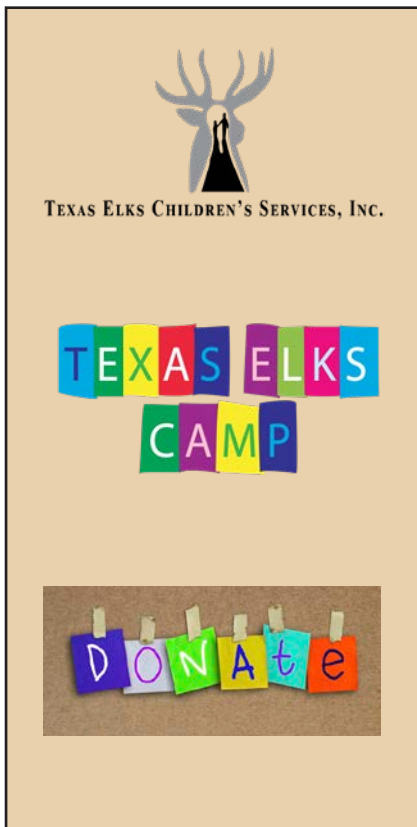

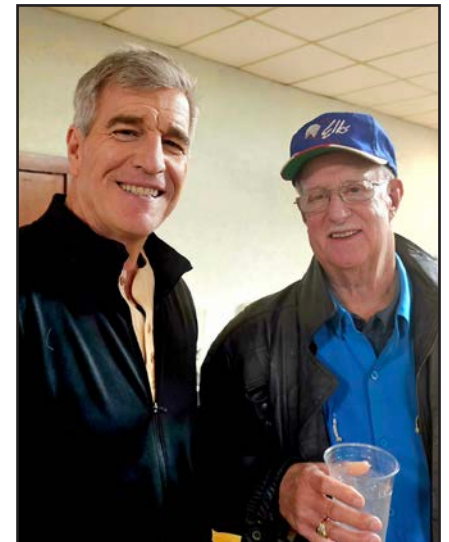
