The kids (little and big) could pet goats, rabbits, and a tortoise and then pet or hold baby chicks, snakes, and a Kinkajou.

Food was also provided for the kids and their families right after the petting zoo, including hot dogs, mac & cheese, chips, cookies, and pop. After their meal, we did an Easter egg hunt for the kids 3 and under and then handed out prebagged candy to the kids 4-10. We also ran two fundraisers during the party: a 50/50 raffle and raffling off two Fire pads to offset the costs of the party.
