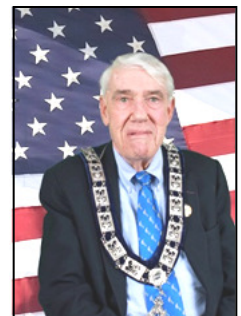
Elk of the Month

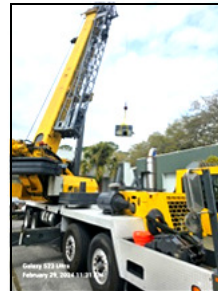

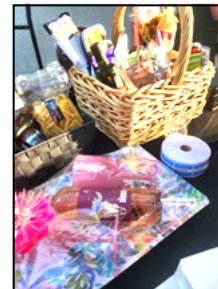

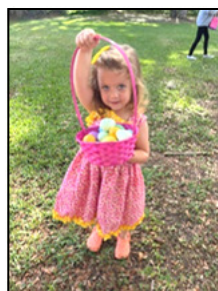
