In addition, the Auxiliary is now accepting applications for **new** memberships.

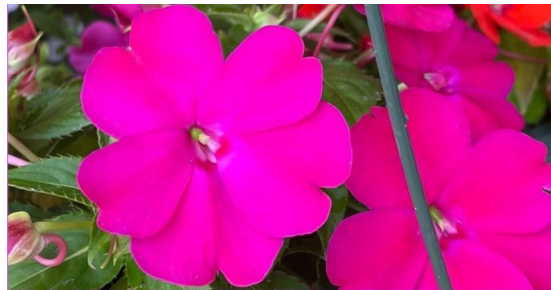
