#### Local Lodge Convention Report

The Elk's National Convention was held in Austin, Texas, from June 30th to July 3, 2024.

On Friday, I flew to Austin, Texas. After arriving, I took a taxi to my hotel and was checked in by 7:00 pm. My room had a gorgeous view.

On Saturday, I attended the Texas Lodge Crawl. We boarded a tour bus at 9:00 am and we made a total of 5 stops. First was Luckenbach, Texas Park, where Texans have been making music and memories since 1849. Then we visited Elks Lodge #216 and next we went to Elks Lodge #2279. The next stop was Elks Lodge #1229, and our last stop was Elks Lodge #2413. We returned to the Convention at 9:00 pm. What a great day, packed full of fun and fantastic people!

During my stay I attended the business sessions, training meetings, the Florida Dinner, and the Florida Hospitality Room. I met so many wonderful Elks from Lodges across America and exchanged Lodge Pins with them. Within the City of Austin, it took at least 12 different hotels to house over 6,500 Elks that met daily at the Convention Center. The marketing Inside the Exhibit Hall was truly exceptional and made us all proud to be members of the Elks. PDDGER Colleen Gallant did a wonderful job hosting the Florida Elks Children's Therapy Booth and explaining our state programs!

My two most important duties at the Convention were:

- 1) Vote to elect the new Grand Exalted Ruler. During the first business session Douglas A. Schiefer from Bucyrus, OH Lodge #156 was elected as 2024-2025 GER.
- 2) Vote on all proposed resolutions. Eighteen resolutions were passed - three were rejected and one was rescinded by the Committee on Judiciary. Details are on the elks.org website.

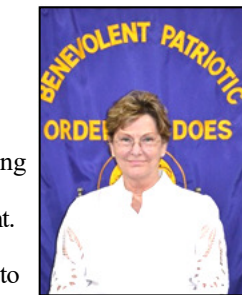
The next **Ways & Means Meeting** is on Wednesday, August 28th. We will be reviewing plans for our fundraising events that are scheduled for the remainder of the year.

In the basement there were four bowling alleys, a gymnasium, grill, kitchen and serving pantry, along with showers, lockers and the boiler rooms.

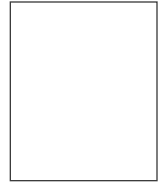
