There is no cost for this program as the Elks pick up the tab for the contestants along with his or her parents. More information and the dates will be published in the newsletter shortly. We had our first meeting for the haunted house and plans are being prepared for the building and decorating of this year's haunted house. If you would like to be involved with the building or as an actor for the haunted house, please leave a message for Andrew Conners at the Lodge and he will return your call and get you scheduled in to help.

There are still a few openings for Officer and Committee people. We are looking for a Chaplain, and a member to chair the Youth Activities Committee and someone to chair the Community activities committee. We still can apply for some grant money from the Elks National Foundation. We already received a freedom grant in support of veterans down at Philadelphia veteran hospital. We have submitted an intent application for an impact grant worth \$10,000. This is a very competitive grant and will cover from January 1st to December 31st of next year. We probably won't hear anything on the status of this application until October. But in the meantime, we will be applying for a gratitude grant, a beacon grant and a spotlight grant. This grant money gives us the opportunity to support activities in our community that the lodge and Elks National Foundation think deserve our attention.

There is only one meeting in August on the 15<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm. All members are welcome to attend.

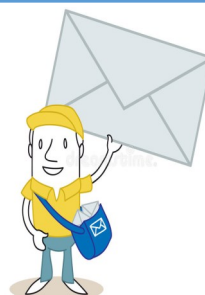
