## ENF Christmas Delivery to Light House

Just a little history about The Light House in Annapolis obtained from their Website. The Light House is a Homeless Prevention Support Center that has served the community as a basic needs provider of food, shelter and support services for over 30 years. We rebuild lives with compassion by providing shelter and services to prevent homelessness and empower people as they transition toward employment, housing and self-sufficiency. Employees of The Light House are ambassadors of goodwill, fostering a trauma informed and harmonious environment by responding, in a positive manner, to the needs of clients, staff, and volunteers while promoting The Light House mission.

As part of our Gratitude Grant of \$3500, ER Andre Denault and the ENF team delivered 41 pairs of boots and 39 pairs of socks to the Lighthouse Shelter in Annapolis who are serving homeless in the area. With the snow on the ground the timing was just right. Good work to the ENF crew as they continue with our charitable works.

We are planning to continue with the Grant money, by replenishing their food pantry.

We were awarded a total of \$10,500.00 from the Elks National Foundation to assist our friends in our community. 👍

Below is the breakdown on how these funds were distributed:

- Spotlight Grant \$2,000.00 Held drive-thru baby shower in partnership with ACAN
- Beacon Grant \$1,000.00 Delivered clothing to the Veterans Hospital in Baltimore
- Beacon Grant \$4,000.00 Delivered 30 food bags each for Thanksgiving and Christmas to Belle Grove Elementary School in partnership with Services from the Heart (Backpack Buddies Program)
- Gratitude Grant \$3,500.00 Currently working in partnership with the Annapolis Light House Thus far, we provided 41 pairs of boots. We plan to prepare a dinner for the residents in the homeless shelter (50-60) We also plan to provide items needed for their food pantry.

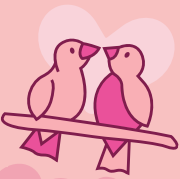
