## TRUSTEE CORNER

The trustees have voted on new tokens for the bar. There will be 4 tokens. Up to \$4, up to \$5, up to \$6 and over \$6. Here is how they will work. Just like the old wooden tokens you pay the price for the drink the person drinks. IE. I want to buy Michael a Highlife. I would pay \$3.50 for the beer and Michael would get a token for up to \$4. When Michael goes to use the chip he can turn it in for a Highlife.

Hold on! What if Michael decides he wants a Jack and coke. That's \$4.75, and his token is only good up to \$4. Well the trustees have thought of that. The tokens can now be used like the red tickets from the video machines. Michael can start a tab and then pay when he leaves with the token and his choose of cash or card. If he is only having the 1 drink he can pay with the token and 75 cents.

The old wooden tokens are still good. However, don't delay using them. Beginning October 1<sup>st</sup> they will only be worth \$3.50.

### THE TOKENS CANNOT BE USED FOR TIPPING THE BARTENDER.

As a reminder. If you personally purchase something for the lodge and it is \$50 or less you can turn that receipt into the bartender and they will reimburse you.. If over \$50 you will need to submit the receipt to the treasurer for reimbursement. **Beginning September 1, 2025 all receipts need to be turned in within 15 days from the date of purchase.** This was decided on by the trustees after consulting out treasurer and accountants.

## West Des Moines Elks Lodge Support Veterans!

This is the second year our lodge has supported the FORE! VETERANS GOLF TOURNAMENT hosted by Central Iowa Shelter and Services to help homeless Veterans in our community.

Elks Members; Dwight Taylor, Greg "Radar" Weinschenk, Jeff Garrison, and Cliff Morris played in the Tournament which was held on July 28, 2025. The Lodge donated \$1800 to support the fundraiser, out of money raised from our Bingo program. The Lodge also donated \$1000 for tickets and food vouchers for 25 Veterans from the Des Moines Veterans Hospital to go to the fair!

The Central Iowa Shelter and Services located at 1420 Mulberry Street in Des Moines is open 24/7/365, serving men and women aged 18 and older who are experiencing homelessness, 10% are Veterans in need of help. They have 150 emergency shelter beds, and each guest may stay for up to 90 days. Upon entry to the shelter, the clients work with case managers and advocates to take advantage of the robust programs and services that will help them secure permanent housing.



On August 23, 2014 our only child Zachary Michael Paulsen, was murdered on the property in front of our family business. Zach was diagnosed with autism at a young age but was high functioning and living a full life, having graduated from WyoTech with a degree in Diesel Technology.

To honor Zach's memory, we established the Zach Paulsen Memorial Scholarship fund for students with autism disorders who want to attend a technical or trade school. To date we have awarded 14 scholarships.
