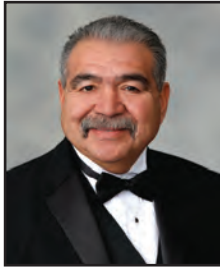

Bill comes from Cedar Rapids IA and after graduating high school in 1974, he enlisted into the United States Air Force (USAF); in 1998, he retired after 24 years. He moved to Modesto, California and is married to his wife Nancy, who is also an Elk, and they celebrated their 13th anniversary in March of 2025. Their combined family includes four sons, two daughters, eight grandsons and three granddaughters.

Trained as a Medical Corpman and subsequently as a Surgical Technician/Assistant, he is experienced working in medical/surgical clinics and hospitals, 14 years of which he served in a management capacity. Bill then came to Modesto to work for a large medical group of physicians. Trained in laser, microwave, and radio frequency surgical techniques, he became part-owner of Hi-Tech Medical Equipment Rentals, LLC in 2008. In 2016 he took over as owner and finally retired in 2022. Bill has attended USAF Senior Non-Commissioned Officer Academy, San Antonio College, Modesto Junior College, and the University of California Davis.

Bryan Robert Klatt was born in DeKalb, Illinois on December 5 to Robert A. Klatt and Donnalee (Bettner) Klatt. He is the oldest of two children, with a younger brother, Mark A. Klatt (Layne). Bryan was raised in DeKalb and graduated from DeKalb High School in 1977.

Bryan graduated from Northern Illinois University in 1982 with a bachelor's degree in industrial arts. During his time in college, he was a five-year student equipment manager for the football team, which earned him a half-ride scholarship for all five years.

After college, Bryan worked with his father and brother at the former Kallal's Sheet Metal Inc. in his hometown. He was with the company for more than 25 years, first as an employee, then as a co-owner with his brother. Bryan is a past chairman of the City of DeKalb HVAC Mechanical board and a former member of the DeKalb Public Library board. He is a member of St. Mary Catholic Church in DeKalb and a Third Degree Knight of the Knights of Columbus Council No. 717, as well as a member of the Loyal Order of Moose Lodge No. 586.

During Bryan's senior year of high school, he was introduced to the former Susan Louise Ekstrom, to whom he has been married since October 1983. They have three children: Gregory Robert, Andrew Jordan, and Lucas Richard (BreeAnne).

When his boys attended and played sports at DeKalb High School, Bryan found a way to watch the action and save the school a little money. He volunteered to be the public address announcer, and stayed in the role for more than a quarter century. Bryan's voice could be heard at the school's football games, boys' and girls' basketball games, wrestling meets, baseball and softball games, and other events. He has also assisted Northern Illinois by announcing baseball, softball, gymnastics, football, and

women's basketball. Bryan is a regular volunteer in his community in various school, civic, and athletic activities.

Bryan was initiated into DeKalb, Illinois Lodge No. 765 on November 12, 1985. He served on numerous committees before becoming Exalted Ruler in 1989-1990 and Lodge Secretary from 1998 to 2009. He is an Honorary Life Member and continues to serve the Lodge when needed to fulfill unexpired Officer terms or committees.

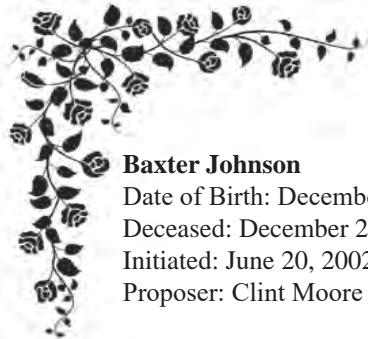

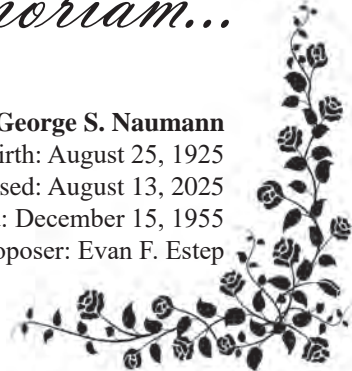

Central District Jamboree

Every year, on the first weekend in October, our Central District hosts a beloved fundraising event: the **Jamboree**. This rotating weekend celebration—held at a different lodge each year—is packed with fun, games, and fierce chili and rib cookoff competitions. But beyond the festivities, the Jamboree serves a vital purpose: **raising funds to support key district programs** like Hoop Shoot, Scholarships, Americanism, Veterans services, and other Elks social welfare initiatives.

The Raffle: A Simple Way to Support

Each year, the Jamboree Committee sends **raffle tickets** to every lodge, which are then distributed to members.

- **Ticket Pack:** 6 tickets for just **\$10**
- **Purpose:** All proceeds go directly to district programs
- **Impact:** Over 40 years of fundraising has built a substantial reserve

Last year, the committee voted to **distribute \$10,000 in grants** to lodges that meet specific participation criteria. This is our chance to bring some of that money back to **Merced Lodge**—but we need to step up.

How Merced Lodge Can Qualify for the Grant

To be eligible for our share of the \$10,000, we must meet **three key requirements**:

1. **Raffle Ticket Sales**
 - We must purchase **one packet of tickets for every 5 members** (20% of membership)
 - Last year, we only reached **4%**—we must do better
 - *Action:* Buy at least one packet when they arrive in your mailbox. \$10 or \$20 goes a long way!
2. **Event Participation**
 - Each lodge must take part in **two Jamboree activities**
 - This includes entering a **chili cookoff team** and joining in the **Jamboree games**
 - Last year, our participation was minimal—let’s change that
3. **Gift Basket Contributions**
 - Each lodge must provide **four raffle baskets**, valued up to \$50 each
 - Merced has always excelled here—let’s keep that tradition strong

Let’s Reclaim Our Reputation

Merced Lodge is a recognized leader in the Central Valley—known for our membership strength, ritual excellence, and leadership. But when it comes to the Jamboree, **we have fallen behind**. It is time to change that.

I’m calling on each of you to help restore our standing.

- **Buy a raffle ticket packet**
- **Join a cookoff team or game crew**
- **Contribute a raffle basket**

Together, we can bring pride back to Merced Lodge and secure funding that directly benefits our members and programs.


