EXALTED RULER'S MESSAGE


Hello Elks,

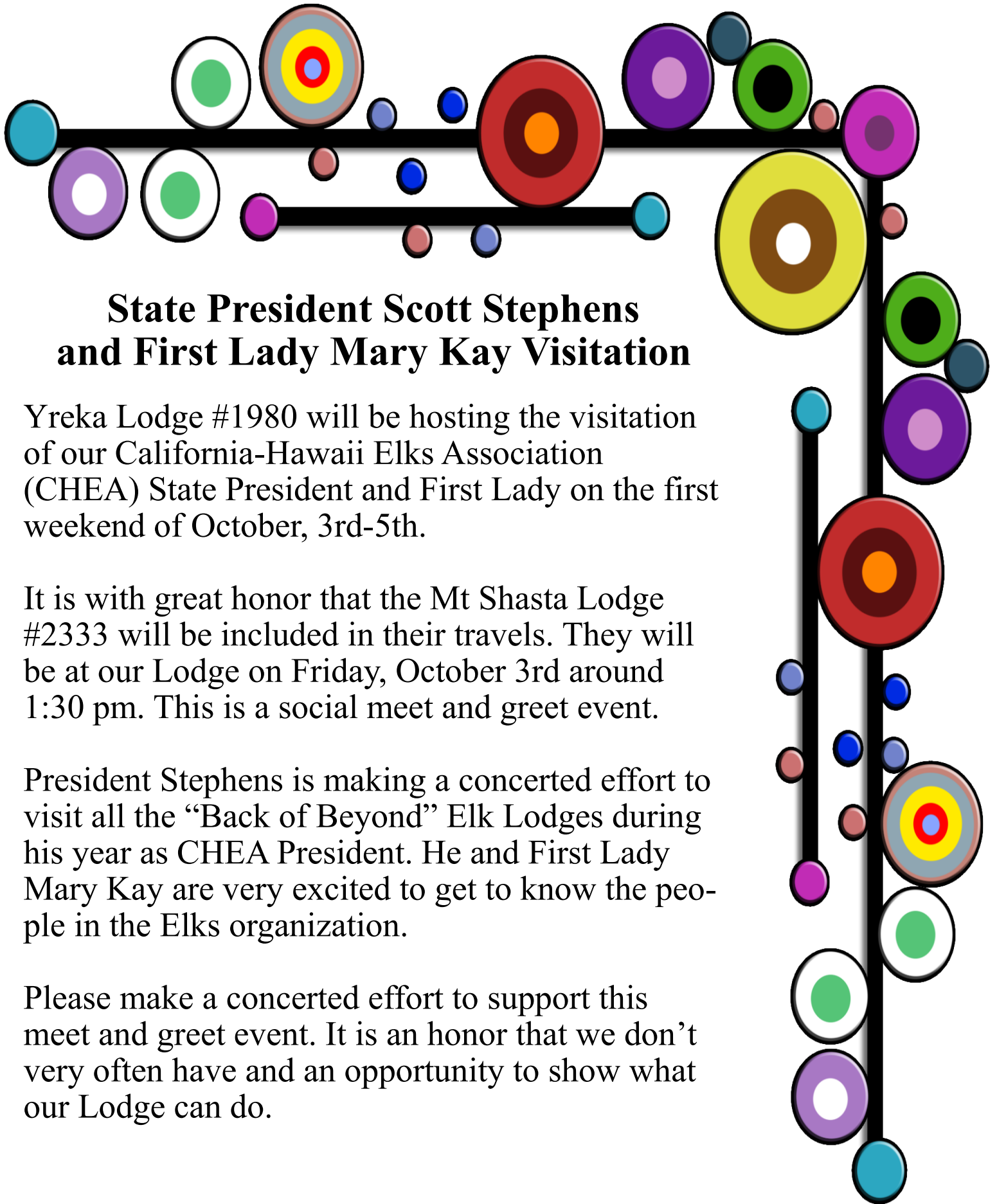

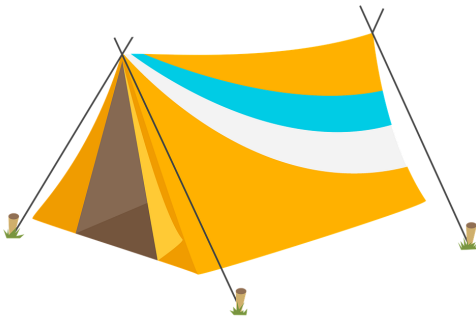
Please make a concerted effort to support this meet and greet event. It is an honor that we don't very often have and an opportunity to show what our Lodge can do.
