Just a reminder, there is only one Board of Directors meeting in December on Wednesday the 3rd and one membership meeting on Tuesday the 9th.

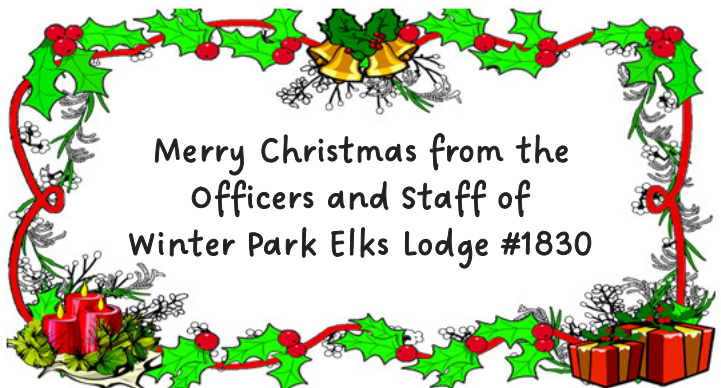
