AWARD GUIDELINES

Gary Carter was an active Elks member for 46 years, and he believed that it was the spirit of service to others that made America great. Gary spent his life serving the community he loved, and this, the "Gary Carter Elks Scholarship" seeks to acknowledge those who have answered the call to community service.

The award of \$1,000 may be used for educational expenses during the first year of college or post-secondary vocational/technical school. The award is given without regard to race, color, creed, religion, gender, or disability.

The Selection Committee judges applications based on the above values. There will be no further investigation of the prospective students or their parents with respect to financial need or other personal matters.

Students must complete the entire 2013 application. The student and Elks member must sign the application. It should be mailed with a current complete high school transcript of grades to the Robinson Elks Lodge No. 1188, postmarked no later than March 15, 2013.

## **ELIGIBLITY CRITERIA**

The applicant must:

- 1. Be a United States citizen.
- Be a child or step-child of an Elk member who joined the order on or before April 1, 2010 is eligible to apply. The Elk must also be a paid-up member through March 31, 2013.
- Be a high school senior. 3.
- Demonstrate participation in community service and/or co-curricular activities.
