Rome Elks Lodge #96 Placed on National Register of Historic Places

Don Campbell and the late Bob Blocker were instrumental in the process to get Rome Lodge #96 placed on the **National Register of Historic Places**.

Our Lodge was constructed in the 1848 as the private home of a local pharmacist. The home changed hands several times before the B.P.O of Elks #96 purchased the building in the 1920's. The current dining room was added as an enclosed porch that same year

The current Lodge room was an addition that was completed in 1934. In 1985—1988 a major renovation of the building was done.

Don was presented with the plaque we received at a recent Lodge meeting. The plaque will be mounted at the front entrance this summer.
