Delinquent Members: Our current total is 20 Members delinquent. The list is posted in the lodge on the Secretary's bulletin board and updated as required. By-Laws/House Rules are due for review/revision. Our Bylaws are required to be reviewed/revised every 5 years and ours are overdue. The By-Law Committee will hold their initial meeting on Wednesday, 07 January 2015 at 1800. If you are interested in this-be there!! As you can see above, we started the Lodge Year 01 April 2014 with 386 Members. We lost 7 members who passed away and issued 1 Absolute Dimit; initiated 9 plus reinstated 1 & Affiliated 1, which puts us at 389 Members. We currently have 4 Applications in the Process.

NEWDues: What went on with the dues for next year you might ask? Well as you know in addition to dues, each member pays Grand Lodge & State Assessments totaling \$19.00 (\$16.00 Grand Lodge & \$3.00 State). Grand Lodge sold the Elks National Home of which \$1.00 was being assessed every member to support the home. This reduced the assessments to \$18.00 but then, the company that provides the Insurance, upped their cost which increased the assessments of each Member by .50 per member, so the assessments went to \$18.50.



ENFNEWS


ENF donations are currently \$2,123 or \$5.50 per capita. We have exceeded the Grand Exalted Ruler's goal of \$4.60 per capita and are eligible for a Gratitude Grant of up to \$2,000 which can be used for projects to meet a need in the community. Grand Lodge is looking for projects that involve active participation by members. If anyone has such a project, I will help you write up the grant application. Grant applications are due sometime in May and the project must be completed by July, 2015. ENF may consider projects which involve donations only, but strongly encourage active Elk participation.
