

Hi again. In last month's Bulletin I reminded all what the ENF does to help Local Lodges in service to their communities and to the Grand Lodge Programs.

There seems to be a misconception, by some of the Members that I have spoken to, that donations to the ENF all go to the Grand Lodge for other than local projects.

Last Elk year the ENF gave back to Massachusetts Lodges and the State Association Major Project (Scholarship) \$2.048 for every dollar donated by Members from Massachusetts. This is a very good return on our investment.

This year the ENF has allocated funds for the following projects:

- Community Investments Program ~ \$9.77 million
- State Elks Association Grants ~ \$8.72 million
- Scholarship Programs ~ \$4.16 million
- Elks National Veterans Service Program ~ \$1.48 million
- Elks Hoop Shoot Free Throw Contest ~ \$924,070
- Elks Drug Awareness Program ~ \$817,890

One way that you can help is by sponsoring a walker who will be participating in the Annual Walk-Around-Lake in September. Walkers will be asking for your support in the near future in an attempt to help raise money for the ENF. Please consider helping them to help you in getting your credit for donations in your name. And also helping your Lodge continue to provide the services to the local community.

If any Member would like to review their personal giving history, please let me know and I will go over it with you.


