GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. This awards program is open to any graduating senior from Chester, Westwood area who will be attending either a two-year or four year college or university. The awards are typically for \$500 or more each, with the Lake Almanor Elks Lodge #2626 providing the funding.
- 2. These Awards are based on 3 criteria: 1. Leadership involvement in both school and community, 2. Scholarship, and 3. Financial.
- 3. All applications must be submitted in their entirety by May 1 of the Award year. Submit all applications to: Scholarship Committee, Lake Almanor Elks Lodge #2626, P.O. Box 1329, Chester, CA 96020.
- 4. An official transcript of the student's high school grades and classes must be included.
- 5. It is required that three of the student's high school teachers or administrators sign the first page of the application.
- 6. All completed applications are reviewed and evaluated by the Lake Almanor Elks Lodge Scholarship Committee. Their decision is final.
- 7. A representative of the Lake Almanor Elks Lodge Scholarship Committee will present awards at the recipients' graduation ceremonies.
- 8. These Awards will be funded to the recipient upon proof of their registration in a college or university. Awards will be forfeited if not claimed within the year of presentation.
- 9. Typed written form, you must submit an essay on plain white 8.5x11 inch paper. No more than 500 words or less than 350 words. Please write about: Using one of the leadership roles or extracurricular activities you prioritized as being important to you, describe what impact the experience had on you, what your contributed, what you learned about yourself, and how it has influenced your plans for the future
