- Guests are welcome. Green fees must be paid prior to playing.

2024 Rates for 18 holes with a cart; Elks \$54, Guests \$60. Additional pricing (Walking, twilight, and group rates) available in pro shop.

- Keep up with the group in front of you. Pace of play is critical.
- This is your Golf course. Keep carts on paths, do not drive near greens.
- Fix ball marks on greens and replace divots in the fairway.
