The response to our Major Projects appeal letter was very good, raising over \$2,000 for Cerebral Palsy Associations of New York. That's a nice total toward our goal of \$4,888. 81 members (out of 629) contributed. Membership stats for Lodge year April 1, 2023 – March 31, 2023. We began with 611 members, 45 Elks were initiated, 5 reinstated, 4 affiliated from other Lodges for a total of 54 additions: 25 members were dropped for non-payment, 3 granted transfer dimits, 2 granted absolute dimits, and 6 deaths for a total loss of 36 members. We ended the year with 629 members, a gain of 18 members for the year.

Don't forget that at the end of May there is a Memorial Day parade followed by a ceremony at the Veteran's Memorial Park on Andrews St. Watch for details and please join your Lodge in the parade. We have had a poor turnout in the past which reflects badly on our commitment to honor and remember our fallen Veterans.
