In closing, let me also thank our amazing Club Manager, Terri Devinny, and her incredible staff for putting up with us when


we don't deserve it, loving us when we need it, and serving us with a smile, EVERY time. You guys are killing it!!!

Charitable Donations Total \$17,500 Approved at the Oct 23, 2025 Lodge Meeting

Families in Need at Christmas. An allocation of \$3,000 was approved to support families facing hardship during the Christmas season. This year, support has been extended to four families, doubling the usual two.

Friends of Bear, Inc. will receive \$2,000. This organization focuses on purchasing bicycles for children at Christmas, in collaboration with the Toys for Tots program.


