## AEA STATE CONVENTION RECAP

Page Elks Lodge officers attended the AEA State Convention in May and returned with several awards! Congratulations to everyone who contributed to these achievements. We also extend our congratulations to all the other lodges that received awards!

### Big Wins for Page Elks Lodge #2498:

- 1st Place – North District Protocol
- 1st Place – Arizona Division III Lodge Bulletin Brochure Contest

### While we're proud of Page Elks Lodge's success, we also celebrate the accomplishments of our fellow Arizona lodges:

- North Lodge of the Year – Payson Lodge
- Arizona Lodge of the Year – Sun City
- \$273,500 in scholarships awarded by the AEA

### Statewide Achievements Across Arizona Elks Lodges:

- 130 baskets were donated by lodges this year, raising additional funds for children's shopping sprees.
- Diamond Club membership is up 34% — please consider joining.
- If every Arizona Elks member gave just \$5 a month (\$60/year), we could raise over \$1 million annually for our major projects.
- \$250,000 was donated to Steele Children's Research Center, with an additional \$100,000 dedicated specifically to cancer research.
- The ER Walk raised \$154,977.20 for AEMP, helping to fund both the Steele Children's Research Center and Jack C. Warters Elks Youth Camp; two programs that provide free services to over 1,000 children and families each year.
