

#### GRAND EXALTED RULER HOWARD R. DAVIS

Madison Lodge is indeed fortunate in having as its honored guest Brother Howard R. Davis from Williamsport Pa., Lodge No. 173. The lodge extends to Brother Davis a sincere welcome and we trust that his stay with us will linger long in his memory.

Brother Davis began his career in Elkdom in 1910, when he was initiated in Williamsport Lodge No. 173. Nine years later he was elected Exalted Ruler. In 1922 he was appointed District Deputy Grand Exalted Ruler for Pennsylvania's North Central District. In the same year he was elected to the Board of Trustees of the State Elks Association; he was elected vice president of the Association in 1928 and presided the following year.

Mr. Davis served two years on the Grand Lodge State Associations committee in 1936-38. Later he was a member of the Grand Lodge Activities Committee and in 1945 he served as chairman of the State Associations Committee.

At the 1943 convention, he was elected Grand Esteemed Leading Knight. In 1946, he was elected to fill a one year vacancy on the Board of Grand Trustees and the following year he was elected to a full, five-year term, from which post he stepped into the Grand Exalted Rulership.
