EXPECTATIONS

- Be respectful, considerate, and inclusive of others.
- Refrain from demeaning, discriminatory, or harassing behavior and speech.
- Follow all event rules and instructions from event staff.
- Support other children and parents by not engaging in bullying.
- Supervise children at all times—children may not attend events or activities without parental supervision.



UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOR

- Harassment, intimidation or discrimination in any form.
- Physical or verbal abuse.
- Unwelcome advances or comments.
- Inappropriate and unwanted physical contact.
- Persistent or intrusive attention.
- Verbal put-downs, teasings or other insulting remarks will not be tolerated.



CONSEQUENCES

Anyone—this includes Finalists too—asked to stop unacceptable behavior is expected to comply immediately. Event organizers may take any action deemed appropriate, including but not limited to:

- Warning the offender.
- Expulsion from the event without refund.
- Exclusion from future events and volunteer roles.
- Reporting to appropriate authorities.

REPORTING CONCERNs OR VIOLATIONS
