The Queen of Hearts Progressive Raffle

The Queen of Hearts is a 60/40 Progressive Raffle

- The Grand Prize increases progressively each week that the Queen of Hearts Card remains unselected.
- 60% of the total ticket sales, after consolation prizes, is awarded to the individual who selects the Queen of Hearts Card.
- 40% is allocated to the Manistee Elks Lodge to support the lodge, ensuring its sustainability and the charities that we support.

Who can participate?

- You must be at least 18 years old to purchase tickets.
- Membership is not required to join the game.





Basic Rules and Guidelines

What are the rules for playing?

- The game begins with a standard deck of 52 playing cards, along with 2 jokers, which are placed in numbered envelopes from 1 to 54 and stored in a locked display case.
- Players purchase tickets for \$5 each, writing their name, phone number, and the envelope number they wish opened if their ticket is selected. Once each week on Friday at 8:00pm we draw a ticket.

It is not necessary to be present to win.

There is a winner every week!

- If the chosen envelope does not reveal the Queen of Hearts card, the winner receives a consolation prize.
- The value of consolation prizes is determined by the card drawn and the overall ticket sales. For instance, if ticket sales were \$2,500 and the drawn card was the Jack of Clubs, the winner would receive \$50, as illustrated in the diagram below.

Prize Payment Schedule for Consolation Prizes				
Total Ticket Sales				
Card	\$0 - \$999	\$1,000 - \$4,999	\$5,000 - \$9,999	\$10,000+
2 to 10 Card	\$10	<u>\$25</u>	\$50	\$100
Face Card	\$25	★\$50 ★	\$100	\$250
Ace	\$50	\$100	\$250	\$500
Joker	\$100	\$250	\$500	\$1,000

All ticket stubs in the bin are discarded, that card is marked and placed face up in the display case. And the game continues the following week with a larger grand prize.

Consolation Prizes



- When the Queen of Hearts card is drawn, that individual receives 60% of all ticket sales, less consolation prizes paid.
- The game resets with all the cards in the display case being marked and discarded, and a new round commences.
