Happy month of May. I hope everyone survived tax time. It is now time to get ready for the heat.

In my last article, we talked about Lodge meetings and wanting you all to come to Lodge meetings. So moving onto our next question, I was asked why we have sign in books? We have the guest logs to make sure that those in the Lodge are allowed to be in the Lodge. These logs protect our members, our employees, our Lodge and our privilege to operate as a private fraternal organization. Our Lodge is part of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks operating under the laws of the order and our approved by-laws, House Rules, and federal tax status. It is our duty to operate accordingly. Our House Rules are clear: members and member guests are not to be admitted without a current membership, and members may be required to show their card at any time. This is not about distrust, it's about standards that are consistent, fair, and enforceable. Non-members are here only as bona fide guests. Our by-laws state that the use of the club facilities is limited to members in good standing, and non-members are permitted if they are accompanied by the hosting member. The member is responsible for their guest's conduct and charges. This is why guests do not sign for purchases and its why staff must ensure the member, not the guest, is the accountable party.

It goes much deeper as far as state laws and accountability to keep records with the internal revenue service to maintain our 501C status; there's a lot to it. So once again, if you are asked to show your membership card, please make sure it is signed to make it a valid membership card. And if you're asked to show your driver's license for one reason or another, please show either one of these with a smile on your face, followed up with a thank you for asking.
