The profile should also include how extreme absences and incomplete work are assessed.
3. A letter of recommendation from a school counselor or teacher. This must fit on one page and be dated and signed by the author.
4. A letter of recommendation from a member of the community or employer. This must fit on one page, one, and be dated and signed by the author.
5. Any other exhibits that you feel will help judge your worthiness for the scholarship.

All applications must be submitted to your local Elks Lodge by that date. No Exceptions.
