
Dear Elks Members,

Our tennis courts have become more popular lately (perhaps due to the recent renovations), which is great! We love seeing people out there using them for both tennis and pickleball!

In an effort to add some organization/structure around the use of these courts we are rolling out an online reservation system using SignUpGenius. This will allow members to reserve a court (or courts) for certain periods of time and also make others aware when they are in use, so people (ideally) won't show up and have to wait around too long for an open court.

This will also allow us to be aware of the times in which the tennis instructors are using the courts for lessons or their summer camps (starting shortly). We will also be able to make people aware of any "open court" times that are scheduled for all members to come out and play in a casual format and get to meet other Elks members/players.

The SignupGenius format allows us to schedule two weeks of activity so a new schedule will be rolled out every two weeks and a link will be posted/available in the Tennis section of our Lodge 1991 Home page (elks.org), see below.
