

### **DDGER CORNER**

A short explanation to the letter below from our District Deputy Ferdinand "PJ" Pati.

All lodges undergo an annual review of their books and records, and a facility inspection. Ours was conducted on September 11, 2023, and the other lodges in our district underwent review and inspection around the same time.

PJ's letter refers to issues found across all seven (7) lodges in our district and most of the items do not refer to Canoga Park.

### **DDGER Corner**

#### **Hello ERs and Members of Metropolitan District,**

First of all, thank you for your time and cooperation extended to me and my Team, Anthony Roman and Penny Reiger, during the DDGER Visitation, Audit and Inspection of your Lodges.

This letter serves as a reminder and a follow-up of your responses, compliances or corrective actions on the issues and findings from our audits and inspections. Below are lists of the most common findings in general:

1. Having no clear passages on Exit doors due to presence of debris or obstructions.
2. Presence of broken pavements and poor lightings in parking lots.
3. Missing mats by the ice machines; missing "Slippery When Wet" signs on designated areas to prevent or avoid accidental slips and falls.
4. Old and/or dirty oven hoods which need to be replaced or cleaned for sanitary purposes and to prevent fires.
5. Harassment Policies are not updated, not signed by officers and employees.
6. Office phones do not have lists of emergency contact names and phone numbers on them.
7. First aid kits are not updated and are not easily accessible.
8. Cylinder beverages are not secured to avoid tipping and accidents.
9. Laundry bags and greasy rags are not covered.
10. Inactive or absence of PER associations which serve as a great source of guidance, expertise and advices, were noted on some lodges. Also noted were lack of actions

to contact PER's, to invite or encourage them to attend meetings or lodge activities actions which could eventually help revive or create a PER association.

11. The need to improve on having an impressive performance with reading Ritual/Initiation ceremony.
12. On Membership and Lapsation, candidates are not being initiated timely or ASAP which could lead to loss of interest on candidates. Also noted was the lack of follow up on lapsation through a call/text/email/ letter or any means of communication.

If any of the findings above are applicable to your lodges, please provide me an update of any corrective actions taken by your lodges. Some ER's have already provided me with their responses on their compliances. Please feel free to contact me to further discuss your lodge's inspection results and findings.

- Also, please note that as part of my DD obligations, I will continue to regularly monitor your Lodge's Charity Reports, ENF contributions and FRS reports.

I will be sending another article before my term ends in July 2024 for updates and to address other areas of concerns. It is my hope that providing updated reports to the incoming DDGER, will facilitate a smoother transition and will be helpful as reference for future lodge's inspections and audits.

Again, thank you for the utmost cooperation and continued support extended to your DDGER, to our great Metropolitan District, and to our entire Elks organization. All the precious time for volunteerism and dedication to our organization truly show that indeed, WE ARE THE ELKS!!!


