





Second Read & Balloting:

- There can be multiple ballot boxes
 - White round marble is a "YES" vote.
 - Black square marble is a "NO" vote
- Name of candidates are listed on each ballot box
 - You will be casting your ballot for all names listed on the ballot box.
 - If you wish to vote No for one or more of the candidates listed on the ballot box use "Black Cube Marble"
 - If the candidates in a ballot box do not get a 2/3 majority. Names will then be put into separate ballot boxes and voting is repeated. The individuals each much get a 2/3 majority YES vote to be elected.






