ENF Grant update

Beacon and Spotlight Grant

On October 13 I had the pleasure of presenting our combined **Beacon and**



Spotlight Grant money to The City Mission of Schenectady. Both of these programs serve a population in need with food insecurity. In addition to providing \$4000 to the food services program that supports the community meal, our members have an opportunity to assist with the preparation and serving of the meal. The mission provides about 700 meals per day to the local community and their residents. The program is supported by donations such as this.

The Weekend Backpack program which services Mohonasen, Schalmont, and Scotia Glenville districts received \$2000. We also have an opportunity to volunteer to pack the weekend bags for this program on Wednesdays from 9 - 11 am. Rich and I have done this and Denise, Tom and Diane will be helping as well. If there is anyone else interested, please let me know so I can get

your name on the list. The City Mission tracks and registers the volunteers.

Gratitude Grant update

This will be the grant that supports our holiday efforts with the City Mission Toy Program, Adopt A Family, Dictionary Project and Things of My Very Own. Watch the newsletter and emails for opportunities to assist with these projects.

ENF Fundraising update

We are still nearly \$1000 short of our goal at this "over half way point". If you can send a donation, no matter how large or small, we will gladly accept. Watch for raffles and 50/50 as an opportunity to win a little something for yourself in the meantime. Our fundraising is from donations with dues and various fundraising



efforts as well as our bottle deposits that don't get returned to the distributor. If we don't raise the funds, it comes out of our budget from other income.


